Day 1: HO CHI MINH CITY ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at the airport, a tour guide will meet you and pick you up at the hotel. Then they will support you to check-in. After that, you can relax for the rest of the day.

Day 2: HO CHI MINH - CU CHI TUNNELS

Start to visit the Cu Chi Tunnels. Discover these fantastic systems developed by the guerrillas fighting in the Vietnam War. You will have an opportunity to see the various weapons which were used in the war on display. Then learn about the innovative ways that the guerrillas survived and fought back in the war. The unique underground system they built remains to tell the story of the Vietnam War. In the afternoon, let's see the highlights of Saigon and learn about the history of some iconic landmarks.

Then we will explore some famous sightseeing in Ho Chi Minh. First, let's start with The Notre Dame Cathedral. Constructed by French colonists from 1877 to 1890, it is recognized as the largest cathedral in Southeast Asia.

Across the road is the Ho Chi Minh City Post Office, a neoclassical architectural building, considered one of the city's prominent attractions. Next, visit the Reunification Palace, which is the home and workplace of the Republic of Vietnam's President.

The next stop is Cho Lon, as known as Chinatown of Ho Chi Minh. This is the home of Chinese Vietnamese people. We will explore the life of inhabitants here as well as some prominent points in traditional Chinese culture like tea-houses and pagodas, especially we will visit the famous Binh Tay Market.

Finish the afternoon by the way visiting the Emperor Jade Pagoda. Also known as the Tortoise Pagoda, this figurine-filled place of worship is considered by many to be Saigon's finest.

Day 3: HO CHI MINH CITY - MY THO - CAN THO

This morning, we will transfer to My Tho. This developing city is located in the Mekong Delta and it is surrounded by beautiful countryside known as the "Rice Bowl of Vietnam".

Firstly, head to visit Vinh Trang Pagoda. This place is decorated with piece of broken pottery. It is covered by a tall white Buddha statue and set amongst the lovely gardens, which contains various flowers, shrubs, lotus lake, tombs, and decorated gates at the entrance.

Continue on a boat ride along the river to view the stilt houses, fruit plantations and fishing villages.

After lunch, let's visit An Khanh, a small village specializing in fruit orchards and coconut sweets. If time permits, you can take a trip through the island by bicycle or on foot (the island is flat and relatively small). In the end, transfer to Can Tho.

Also, if you want to learn more about Ky Co, please ask our tour guide to take you to the waterfall, freshwater lake to take great photos.

Continue to visit Eo Gio - The most beautiful view to see a sunset in Vietnam. Eo Gio is as beautiful as Jeju Island of Korea. Then, back to Quy Nhon center. Overnight in Quy Nhon.

After that, let's enjoy a Water Puppet Show, which shows the flexibility of the performers in controlling the wooden water puppet and demonstrating Hanoi's rich culture. When the show is over, you will be back at the hotel and spend the night in Hanoi.
